- Physical Form (Yellow Card)

- Records Release Request Form (to request prior school transcripts/grades/standard test scores/IEP/EP (if applicable))

School Uniforms:

ECMS is a uniform school. T-shirts or polo type shirts colored teal, purple or grey should be purchased through [Apparel Expressions](#) (information enclosed). Khaki (light tan), black or navy blue pants, shorts and/or skirts (**length MUST be at the knee**) may be worn. Blue denim jeans are allowed (no holes/patches in jeans). No gym shorts or pants. All uniform shorts or pants must have side pockets and a zipper in the front.

All shoes must completely cover the foot. Tennis shoes are the most common. No flip-flops or sandals allowed.
